Sample Course 2: Hazard Assessment

The course focusses on the identification and the assessment of hazards and risks within the organization's working processes. It aims to establish a deeper understanding of the different types of hazard factors. The course enables the participants to identify hazards and risks as well as their sources. The course is conceptualized as action-oriented format with active involvement of the participants and the application of best practice examples. It is to be regarded as immersion to the introductory course. Due to the vast amount of hazard factors the course will focus on a selection of common hazards and risks; individualized courses can be developed upon request.

Learning outcomes

On completion of the training, participants can

- differentiate the different types of hazard factors and their consequences to health
- prepare and implement inspections at the workforce in order to identify hazards and risks
- assess identified hazards and risks regarding their impacts on employees' safety and health
