Sample Course: Cooperation and Communication in TVET

Cooperation and professional networks have increasingly become fundamental requirements for the implementation of quality in TVET. Understanding the complex TVET system and acknowledging that institutions are no longer working in isolation, forms the basis for entering into mutual beneficial cooperation agreements. This course helps analysing different key stakeholders such as TVET authorities, companies, students and their parents and local communities. It provides tools for evaluating the different interests and influences in order to develop appropriate cooperation and communication strategies.
