Sample Course 3: Developing Demand-Oriented Occupational Standards

The participants will get a basic training on how to develop demand-oriented and high-quality occupational standards. It guides through the whole process, from competence and skill demand analysis, planning, conducting and managing standards development processes and writing occupational standards and related documents and transferring them into curricula. This course follows up on the course "Labour Market and Training Demand Analysis" (course 1) of this module but can also be taken independently.

 Content, elements, format and duration can be customized to the respective needs

On completion of the training, participants can

- describe the structure, content and underlying principles of modern competence-based occupational standards
- facilitate processes of standard development
- write standards and additional relevant documents
- draft concepts of occupational standard implementation

- Analysis of labour market research
