Sample Course 4: Recognition of Prior Learning

The course aims to introduce participants into the concept of Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL). It furthermore empowers teaching and administration staff of TVET institutions to plan, develop and conduct assessments and examinations of prior learning with the purpose of enrolling to a programme or to certify prior learning in a vocational certificate.

- translate an occupational standard into assessments and conduct these assessments
- discuss the different areas and methods of summative assessment and their pros and cons
- explain the assessment and examination process and relevant steps
- plan, design, conduct and evaluate competence-based and work-related practical assessments and examinations
