Strategic TVET Management and Institutional Leadership

Sample Course: TVET Governance, Policies and Strategies and their Impact on Institutional Level

TVET management staff of TVET institutions are often challenged by national TVET reform processes (e.g. financing, cooperative TVET) designed to increase the efficiency, relevance and responsiveness of the TVET system and its institutions. Since those policies and strategies need to be integrated into the day-to-day work of a TVET institution, better knowledge on the purposes of the reform and its feasibility at institutional level is essential to ensure its implementation and an overall acceptance by the members of the school.

Therefore, this course aims at enabling the management of TVET institutions to breakdown and implement national TVET policies and strategies at institutional level.

- know about the course of policy development and policy formulation, relevant stakeholders at national level
- are able to interpret, explain and compare national policies and strategies of their respective countries
- are able to identify stakeholders involved in the reform process

- are able to identify personnel and financial resources for the implementation of national TVET reforms and know how to apply for it

- Identification of the most relevant TVET reform issues for the participating countries
- Comparison of TVET systems
- Educational / sector policies and TVET policies and strategies
- Exemplary analysis of national policies
- Financing mechanisms of TVET
