





#### **Complementary activities**

- IT infrastructure renewal at 7 partner schools
  - Assessment of infrastructure
  - Procurement and installation
  - Training of IT personnel

- Registration for Microsoft 365 **Education package** 
  - Obtaining domain and MS 365 A1 License
  - Registrate 7 partner schools & develop guideline for sector
  - Elementary training for teachers and admin

- Development of eLearning material
  - Support for 12 activities to develop **eContent**
  - "Technical work planning", "OSH in construction sector", "WASH"...
  - Content available via LMS Moodle

- **Piloting Digital Tool Management System** 
  - Open Source System piloted at 2 partner schools

#### eLearning in TVET - Mongolia end of 2021 and beyond

#### Status quo

- Piloting of Moodle LMS with 3 partner schools
- In-company trainer course running
- Course by National Assessment, Information and Methodology Centre running



#### Activities to follow

- Manage translation and editing of Moodle, create video instruction for editing translations
- Prepare general information about TVET LMS, terms of use, data protection information
- Prepare FAQ for Moodle users
- Implement Moodle LMS with 3-4 other schools
- Establish local technical support
- Support 31 trained multiplier trainers in training implementation
- Connect to outside entity TVET Management Information System
