OUR LEARNING OPTIONS FOR ACCOMPANYING PARTNERS (MAP)

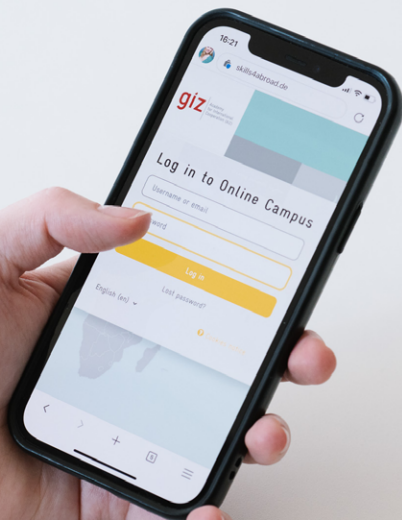

ACCOMPANYING PARTNERS

This training gives you a holistic overview of your **personal development and the relationship** with your spouse in the context of your joint stay abroad. You are best prepared for going abroad together with your partner as well as the opportunities and challenges in your country of assignment as a couple. You are able to reflect on your own role as well as your professional goals and are now able to successfully implement these, also in the aspect of self-care.

THIS COURSE HELPS YOU TO

- › prepare for the **process of arrival a couple** as well as your first steps together in the country of assignment in an ideal way.
- › reflect on your own **personal role in terms of your relationship with you partner and / or family**.
- › realising your personal and / or **professional goals**, planning them realistically and implementing them successfully.
- › attribute the value of **self-care** in difficult situations,
- › prepare for your **return** or prepare for a second deployment in a different country abroad.

MOVING AND LIVING ABROAD WITH CHILDREN

This training gives you a holistic view of the opportunities and challenges your children face going and living abroad. You will learn how to plan as a family and you will help your children to cope with the different stages of departure and during your stay in the country of assignment.

THIS COURSE HELPS YOU TO

- › support your children in an **age-appropriate, diversity-sensitive and anti-racist way** during departure, arrival, and getting settled in your host country.
- › become familiar with the sociological term **third culture kids** as well as the special challenges and opportunities linked to that.
- › recognise signs of **culture shock or homesickness** in children, sensitise for cultural complexity in the context of transcultural learning and develop individual coping strategies.
- › get to know the advantages and disadvantages of different types of **schools** in your host country as well as generating clarity on your own decision-making criteria.
- › gain an understanding of **multi-lingualism** and accompanying children appropriately in language learning.

Time 2 Learn – focus on your learning:

Individually tailored courses to your needs and interests which will focus on your learning goals during your stay abroad.

In the course **“Learning 4 Development – focus on your topic”** you will choose a topic related to your professional or personal life abroad and you will be guided by your tutor. This in-person or digital training is available several times a month and lasts 2-3 days.

“Time 2 Learn – focus on your learning” offers the opportunity to tackle topics of your choice individually, in exchange with other participants, and/or with the support of our Campus Library staff. In addition to an optimal learning environment, more than 25,000 media and numerous impulses to network and learn await you. This half-day offer is available twice a month at the Campus Kottenforst.

CONSULTING SESSIONS

Even the most thorough preparation can't always cover every eventuality. Every country and family situation are different. For most of our courses we therefore offer up to three additional consulting sessions with your trainer. These sessions are available up to 12 months after completing the respective course and can be booked via the Online Campus.

A FAMILY-FRIENDLY ENVIRONMENT

Our learning facility Campus Kottenforst in Bonn-Röttgen offers a great place for children. Families are usually accommodated in the **family apartments surrounded by greenery** and close to the woods. There are many **leisure activities** available on your doorstep, including table tennis and indoor bowling. There are playgrounds nearby, football fields and many nature areas including a pond. The surrounding areas also offer the opportunity for exploration and beautiful day trips for the whole family.

KIDS' CAMPUS (KICA)

So that our participants can fully engage in their preparation for moving abroad, families have childcare at their disposal directly on Campus Kottenforst. This is a perfect environment for youngsters to mingle and meet other children in a similar situation. Our experienced and **qualified childcare workers prepare your children for their lifechanging experience by providing and stimulating age-appropriate activities**. Children from 1 to 12 years of age are welcome. Younger children can be looked after by one of our babysitters. Older children have access to school in Bonn-Röttgen.
