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Proposal Writing Training: Crash Course for CBOs

For (potential) implementing partners of CLIP and other NGOs/CBOs providing services to refugees and host communities to develop their skills in conceptualising and writing project proposals for funding.

Contents of the training include, among others:

- Clarification of basic concepts in proposal writing (objective, aim, target group, impact, outcome, output and activity)
- Initial steps of proposal writing (needs analysis, SMART goals, indicators, strategies, resources and planning)
- Theory of change
- Design of a logical framework
- Stakeholder mapping
- Activity plan and implementation basics

The training will be supported by writing support in form of coaching as well as a follow up atelier on project management.

Project Management Atelier

For implementing partners of CLIP and other NGOs/CBOs as well as social service staff from local authorities active in refugee response, to advance their skills in project implementation and management.

The atelier is conceptualized as a tailor-made follow up of the proposal writing training. It is structured as a practice-oriented measure rather than a training, to which participants come with existing workplans, organization charts, stakeholder maps and logframes.

Contents of atelier include, among others:

- Project implementation basics
- Preparation/revision of workplans and stakeholder maps
- Keynote inputs on requested problem areas
- Peer learning through cases: presentations of showcases among participants

The content will be structured according to the needs of participants, as collected before the atelier.

Debating Against Stereotypes (ToT)

For implementing partners of GIZ and local/central authorities active in refugee response, for developing and testing strategies to counter discriminatory slogans/clichés effectively.

The training builds upon a training format which has been developed by Prof. Dr. Klaus-Peter Hufer (University of Duisburg) under the original name “Argumentationstraining gegen Stammtischparolen”. It has been spread across various Central European countries as part of civic education programs and adjusted to the Turkish context by CLIP.

Contents of this ToT include, among others:

- Discuss ways stereotypes are constructed and put into wording and/or action
- Expand capacities towards countering discriminative phrases and slogans
- Train trainers who can implement sessions on the same topic in their own organizations.

Contents of this training include, among others:

- Legal framework of international protection and temporary protection
- Detention, deportation and legal aid
- Labor law and work permits
- Family law, marriage, divorce and custody
- Residence permits
- Citizenship and legislative amendments
- Child protection
- Gender based violence (GBV)
- Case studies for practice
- Q&A session for each topic

Contents of this training include, among others:

- Basic knowledge on social and psychological effects of violence, loss and trauma
- challenges in working with host communities and refugees
- Recognition of personal stressors, needs and limitations
- Ways of building supportive and stabilizing interaction with people affected by traumatic experiences

MHPSS for Professionals (by Regional MHPSS Program of GIZ)

For technical staff providing psychosocial support and mental health services for refugees and host communities in community centers.

The training will be provided by the regional program of GIZ on Mental Health and Psychosocial Support for Syrian and Iraqi Refugees, IDPs and host communities.

Contents of this training include, among others:

- Psychosocial effects of violence, loss and trauma
- Strategies and techniques for stabilization, resource orientation and de-escalation
- Trauma-informed counseling for individuals, families and groups
- Strengthening capacities for self-care and staff care
