Great! You can do any work :

- Find a farm. Agree on your terms. The farmer needs to ensure your transport back home.

- Get authorization from Commission for Refugees.

- Get a contract (which is good for you and the farmer!)

APPLY FOR A WORK PERMIT :

- Prove your status :
Residence status (ID, documents, or a local leader confirming your status) ;
CoR & UNHCR can help



- Get approval from DOL:
Pay the fees and get your work permit at DOL



- Search for job :
Website, ministries, personal networks, social media, CoR can help with letter of recommendation



- Get a work contract :
....between you and your employer. It aims at protecting your rights and the employers' rights.
