Financial insecurity is a major concern, as more than two-thirds of the elderly in India live below the poverty line. For the seminar, **Dr Rinku Murgai** will present recent studies on the delivery of social pensions to the elderly and widows undertaken by her along with Shrayana Bhattacharya, Maria Mini Jos and Soumya Kapoor.*

**Dr Murgai** is a Lead Poverty Specialist in the Poverty Global Practice of the World Bank, based in New Delhi. She has a PhD in agricultural and resource economics from the University of California at Berkeley, and her work focuses on poverty and inequality measurement; functioning of labour, land and water markets; and social protection design, delivery and evaluation.
