RESULTS AND IMPACT

174 persons have found jobs

55 Micro Small and Medium Enterprises were trained and 40 MSMEs received grants



46 start-ups were initiated





RESULTS AND IMPACT OF COVID19 RESPONSE MEASURE

- Sanitary conditions were improved for more than 33000 internally displaced persons
- Water and sanitary facilities were rehabilitated in 16 schools and IDP collective centers
- > 154 disadvantaged school graduates received internet packages and computers
- > 1330 IDPs were supported with household items
- The rehabilitation of community center "Chemi Mordu" was supported

- A study was conducted on community resilience during COVID-19
- 33 small farmers and 5 social enterprises were supported
- > 2 local media actors were capacitated

Following enterpeneurship training, I have notably developed my sewing salon business, even presented my collection abroad, which I am very proud of.


After joining the Women's
