## Land Information Systems Intern (Re-advertisement)

### MAIN TASK AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Support the organization of regular meetings and workshops with government partners and other stakeholders, including the
  drafting of agendas and presentations, preparation of meeting rooms, meeting documentation, and translation
- Support GIS related tasks to prepare land use planning datasets for the upload to LUIS, the web-based land use information management system. This task contains different steps such as:
  - data preparation (collect spatial data, reports, maps, and metadata)
  - data quality checking & data cleaning (following the standard operation procedures in QGIS)
- Support data upload of geospatial data and metadata to the online land use planning data management system (LUIS)
- Support the development of style files in the Lao language for the new harmonized land use coding schema that is used in LUIS
- Creation of GIS-supported spatial maps for spatial analyses and as an information basis for the implementation of land tenure recognition in forest areas and for political dialogue
- Supporting the team and team leader in the preparation and implementation of activities

#### **REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:**

- Student or recent graduate in any course related to spatial data management (QGIS), natural resource management, land administration, forestry, or related fields
- Experience with GIS needed, preferably QGIS
- Very good communication and organizational skills, and experience in organizing workshops and events are an advantage
- Very good skills in Microsoft 365 applications like Microsoft Word, Excel, and PowerPoint as well as business communication tools
- Basic written and oral communication skills in English
- Self-motivated and willing to learn new skills and work in an international team to implement activities with the public sector in Lao PDR
