B. Project Background

The Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH is a German federal enterprise. We work to shape a future worth living in over 120 countries around the world.

Since 2013, GIZ and the International Placement Services (Zentrale Auslands- und Fachvermittlung, ZAV) of the German Federal Employment Agency (Bundesagentur für Arbeit, BA) cooperate in the joint programme "Triple Win" for the recruitment of nurses from third countries for placement of work in Germany.

In Kerala, the annual number of graduate nurses surpasses the domestic demand on the labour market, and Kerala nurses show interest in a career abroad. While in Germany, the nursing sector is facing a significant shortage of nurses, which is projected to still grow in the future.

In December 2021, the registered Government company Norka Roots ("Non Resident Keralites Affairs") and the Federal Employment Agency (Bundesagentur für Arbeit, BA) have signed an agreement on the Placement of Indian Health Professionals from the State of Kerala/India in Employment as Registered General Nurse in the Federal Republic of Germany. The objective is to establish a safe, orderly and regular mechanism for the recruitment and placement of Kerala nurses for work in Germany. The placement agreement is now being implemented in cooperation with Norka Roots through the Triple Win programme. An extension to this agreement has come into effect in 2024 for trainees, studying nursing in Germany.

Global Skills Partnership is a new project initiative under the bigger umbrella of Skill Labor Mobility in Triple Win, with the aim of equalization of curriculum at the country of origin.

To support the implementation of the Global Skill Partnership Project, the project is now looking for **one (1) candidate** in the Vocational Training and Labour Market Assistant role

C. Responsibilities

- Project Management

D. Core Scope of Tasks

1. Project Management

- Point of Contact for candidates, nursing institute in the country of origin and GIZ Project team
- Document critical steps and process (for example: additional training, payment transfer) for internal documentation and external communication.
- Periodically checking whether additional skills and competencies are progressing in adherence to the timeline. Raise attention if bottlenecks and challenges emerge.
- Plan and manage delegation visit to and from Germany in a timely manner, adhering to the project timeline.
- Preparation, Verification of invoices and other regulatory documents as per requirement.

2. Candidate Management

- Act as a contact person for project participant nursing students providing them guidance and clarity of the process in a periodic manner.
- Monitoring the nursing student's language progress with language service provider.
- Periodically conduct info sessions to address topics of integration into Germany and orientation of working style in Germany.
- Liaise with the German Embassy for visa-related matters. Facilitate/support booking of visa appointments via VFS portal.
- Update nurses on the status of their employment contract and DMW appointments.
- Lead enrollment and disbursement of insurance prior to deployment.
- Provide nurses with flight information and initiate pre-departure preparations.
- Coordinate booking of e-tickets with GIZ's procurement unit/partner travel agency.

3. Stakeholder Management

- Coordinate closely with partner institute in the country of origin especially with their faculty and administration.
- Schedule and finalize interview dates with nursing students and partners (both in country of origin and in Germany).
- Provide continuous updates and communication flow among all key stakeholders: nursing students, SIMET College, GIZ Office Kerala, and GIZ Germany.

Other duties/additional tasks

- Take initiatives to keep the candidates motivated in their journey
- Participate in interdepartmental task teams and strategic initiatives.

E. Required Qualifications, Experience and Competencies

- University Degree in nursing, health, accounting/commerce or social sciences.
- Minimum 2 years of experience.
- Experience in related domain of nursing/health and advisory services for students' group.
- The ability to provide advise candidates and manage stressful situations will be critical. There might be need to provide advice to parents in certain cases.
- Ability to speak the vernacular language (Malayalam) is important as a lot of interaction will be with candidates

- Focus Competence areas: documentation and engaging with candidates.
