in order to provide support for development and delivery of Capacity Building activities to the key stakeholders in the health, education, labour and employment sectors on topics related to climate change and sustainable development.

The aim of the Project is to straighten climate change capacities of national institutions and to shift towards sustainable human capital development in the sectors of health, education, and labour and social protection. The project is implemented by the GIZ Office in Skopje and the Cabinet of the Deputy President of the Government in charge of economic affairs, and it is financially supported by the Green Climate Fund Readiness and Preparatory Support Programme. The duration of the project is 24 months.

Task of the expert include:

- Perform capacity needs assessment on educational sub-sectors: primary, secondary (including Vocational Education and Training), and higher education, formal and non-formal education on the integration of climate change.
- Develop a training package on sustainable development and climate change for the teaching staff, and relevant CSOs, and conduct pilot trainings for the teaching staff and schools' managerial staff.
- Implement pilots on integration of sustainable development and climate change education into six (6) public schools (from rural and urban areas).
- Conduct and support the consultation process by organizing meetings and trainings with the relevant stakeholders, in the country and online.

1.	<u>Education:</u> - University degree in environmental studies, climate policy, education studies, pedagogy, management, sustainable development, political science, social science, or another related field.	
2.	<u>Professional experience:</u> - 5 years of professional experience in climate change, education, sustainable development, and/or educational capacity development.	
3.	<u>Specific Experience:</u> (a) Proven working experience of 4 years in the field of capacity needs assessment in the field of education for sustainable development and climate change. (b) Knowledge of the educational system in the country, especially the primary, secondary and vocational education. (c) Working experience of 4 years directly with primary and secondary (including VET) education schools (teachers and management) of schools in the country. (d) Experience in conducting capacity development activities with teachers and capacity for training material development and training delivery in the field of climate change and sustainable development.	
4.	<u>Language:</u> - Business fluency in English; Excellent oral and written communication skills and ability to report clearly both verbally and in writing on English.	
5.	In the past five years the expert has implemented at least 1 similar assignment in North Macedonia (including reference for the assignment).	

Each applicant may apply for maximum one of the four expert positions.
