1. BACKGROUND

Vocational training systems, globally, often lack alignment with industry needs. Graduates may be formally certified, but often have had little to no exposure to the workplace they have been trained for.

Companies find they must provide additional training to compensate for this, which involves making investments, undermines trust in the performance of public training institutes, and makes entrepreneurs reluctant to hire young trainees without work experience. Formal state certificates lose their value if the holders have only a tenuous grasp of the skills their certificate attests.

Build4Skills is a globally operating project funded by the **German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ)**.

The Asian Development Bank (ADB) and GIZ have formed a strategic partnership united in the belief that infrastructure measures hold an untapped potential for work-based training. By combining TVET measures, inspired by the German dual training system, and ADB's strong engagement in infrastructure, Build4Skills demonstrates how inter-agency cooperation addresses the prevalent lack of industry-driven, practical vocational training. Build4Skills is operating small-scale pilot interventions in Pakistan and Mongolia.

As of June, we are expanding our operations to Kenya, Senegal and South Africa. We intend to cooperate with the **African Development Bank (AfDB)** and other investors in construction measures to promote workplace-based training.
