With growing social challenges around the globe, young people can take the lead towards sustainable and positive social change, on and off the field. As a universal language and a passion shared all over the world, football can play a part in developing the skills and competencies to become socially responsible leaders, build bridges and connect people and cultures.

Increasingly young people are taking leadership roles, addressing global challenges, and taking space in shaping their future. In terms of Gender Equality, women and girls are still facing problems and obstacles worldwide which prevent them from reaching their potential. This is also reflected in the sporting field where women are underrepresented, whether as players, officials or in leadership positions in associations. Through football, it is possible to change the narrative by providing skills and competencies to create equality in sports.

With the EURO 2024 in mind, the organisers have decided to put special emphasis on the growth of female leaders in the region of Western Balkans. The 5-day-course will take place in Durrës, Albania, and will look at all relevant dimensions of leadership, its methodological basis and the application of concepts such as diversity, inclusion and sustainability within the sport context.

Participants will have the opportunity to share their experiences and learn from experts in leadership, organisational and personal development. Besides theoretical knowledge and methods, participants will jointly develop strategies for approaching diverse challenges and receive guidance on the application of newly acquired skills within their specific settings. FLF will enable participants to lead social change within their respective organisations.
