Early cooperation from 1992 until 1999 between Germany and the four Lower Mekong Basin (LMB) countries focused on regional forest assessments and monitoring

From 1995 until 2002, German cooperation was extended through a project between German Technical Cooperation (GTZ) and Mekong River Commission (MRC), focusing on sustainable natural resource management in the LMB region

GTZ cooperation with MRC directed efforts towards sustainable management of watersheds in the LMB countries, contributing to MRC activities in Agriculture, Irrigation, and Forestry

Partly in parallel, from 2004 to 2011, a German-MRC cooperation programme on flood protection and disaster risk management was implemented in the four LMB countries
