Programme Description

The Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH manages change, provides know-how, develops solutions, acts as an intermediary, is value-driven, advises policymakers, secures results, is a global player and is guided by the principles of sustainability. GIZ supports the Southern African Development Community (SADC) Secretariat, through the Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) Unit by implementing the SADC/GIZ Project "Global Initiative on Disaster Risk Management (GIDRM)" funded by the German Ministry of Economic Development and Cooperation (BMZ). The objective of GIDRM is to build capacities and skills of selected decision-makers and regional organizations and initiatives in Southern Africa and other global regions to enable the use of risk-informed development (RID) principles while taking account of context-specific fragility factors.

To address the complex nature of risks and safeguard sustainable development, GIDRM aims at strengthening risk governance and risk-informed development (RID) in the region. RID is an understanding of development that considers multi-faceted, dynamic, interdependent, transboundary, simultaneous, and systemic risks. It thus describes a shift in mindset and practice across sectors and stakeholders from managing single hazards towards incorporating existing and future risks in all development processes from the outset and therefore choosing development pathways that prevent the creation of risks.

Alongside strengthening SADC DRR Unit for the inclusion of gender-responsive and RID-based approaches in development activities, GIDRM implements in conjunction with other GIZ projects and in partnership with SADC, risk-informed development interventions in priority regional value chains and/or sectors at the SADC national or subnational level. Professional Experience
