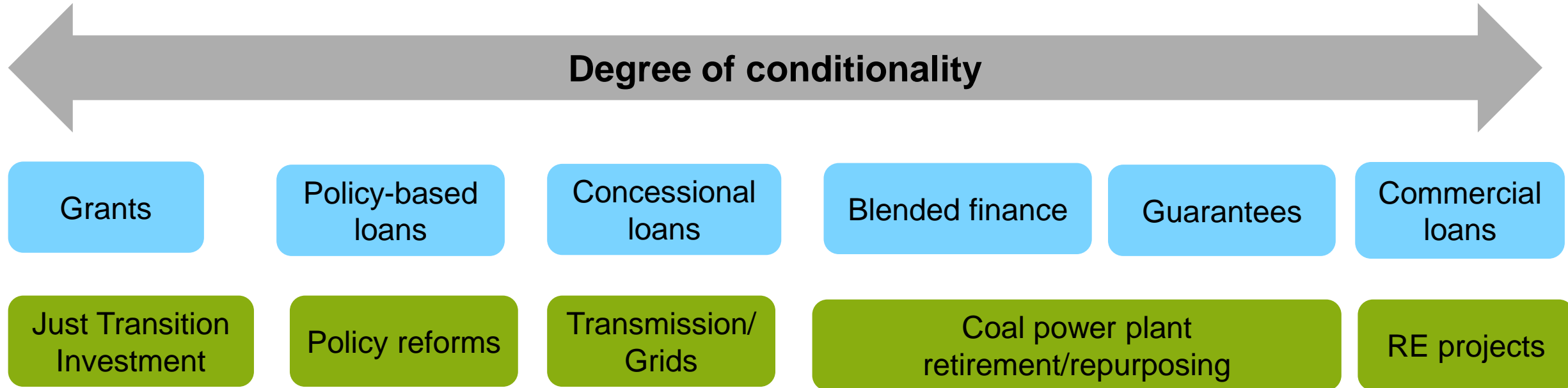
JETP Finance

- Total volume: **Team GER** on avg. ~10 – 15 % of IPG finance (Old/New)
- Composition: **grants vs. loans** (Team GER grant frontrunner)
- Private finance: **conditional upon policy reforms**

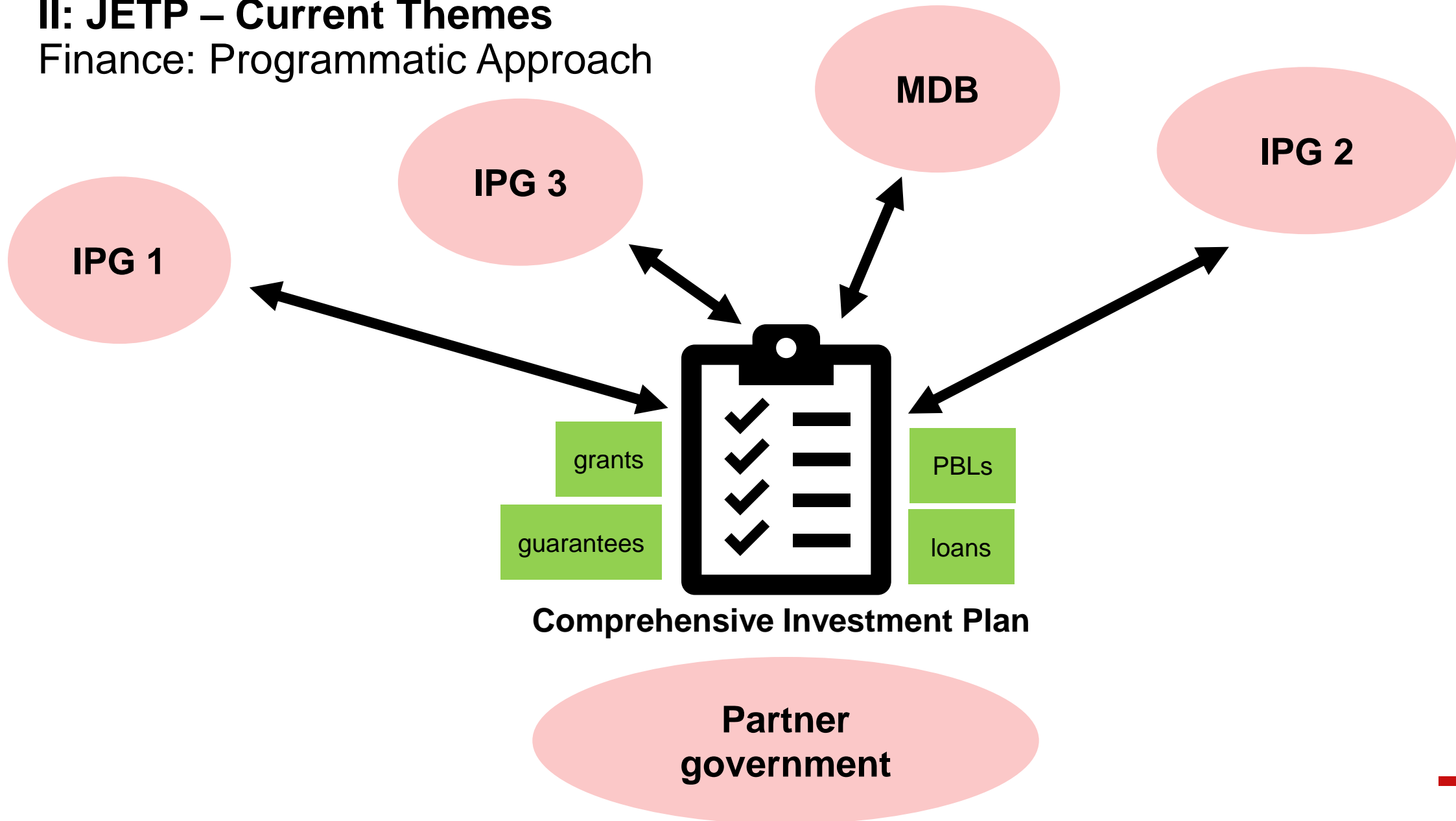
Effective use of public finance

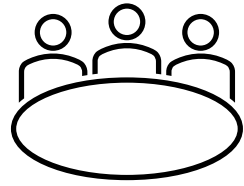

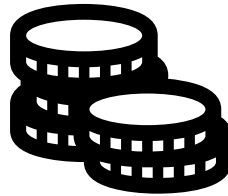

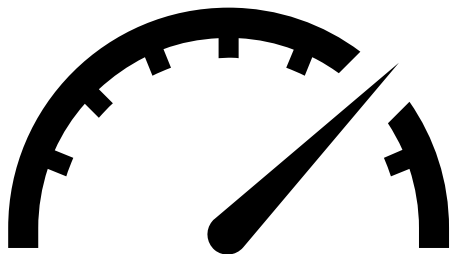

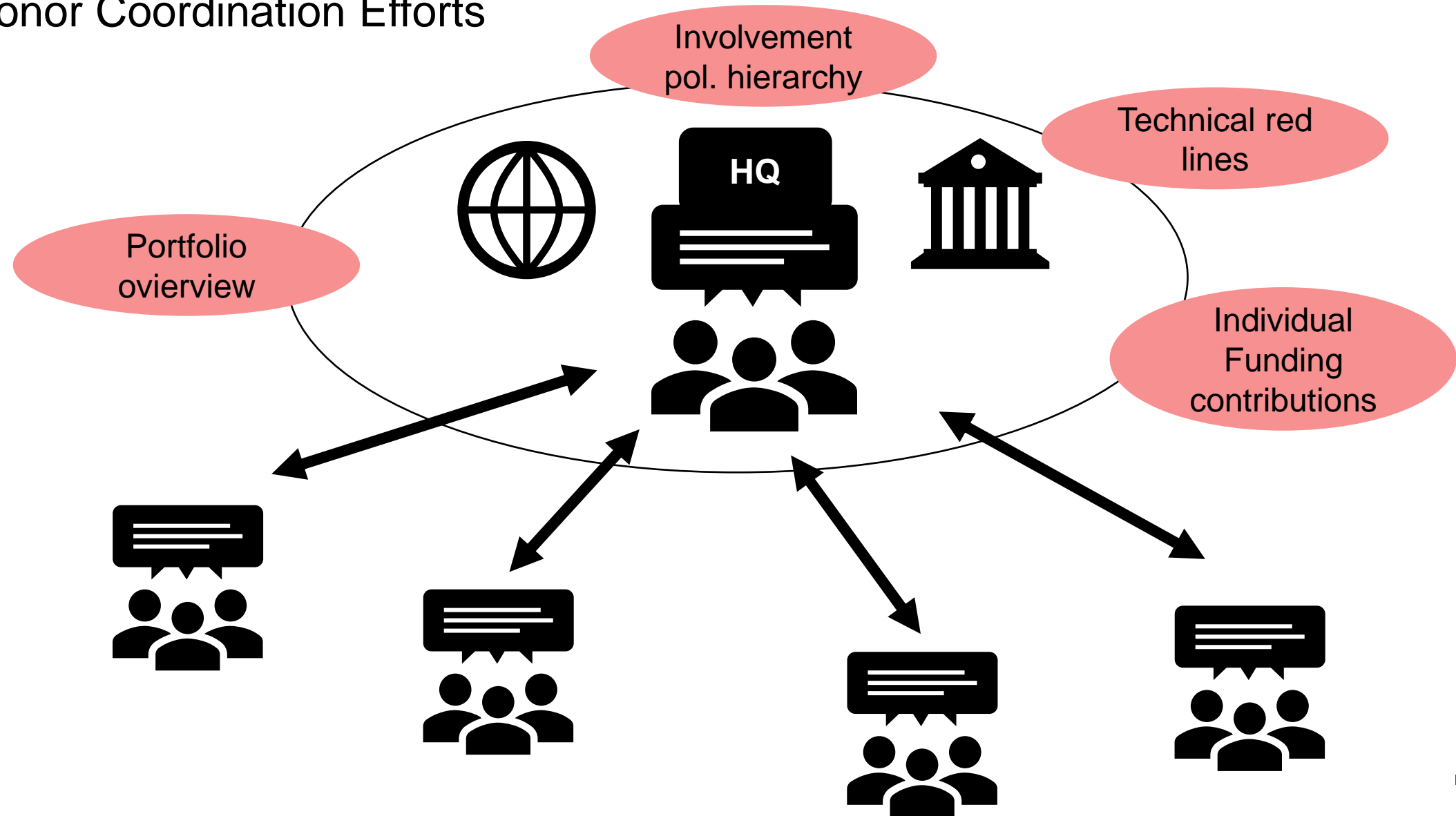

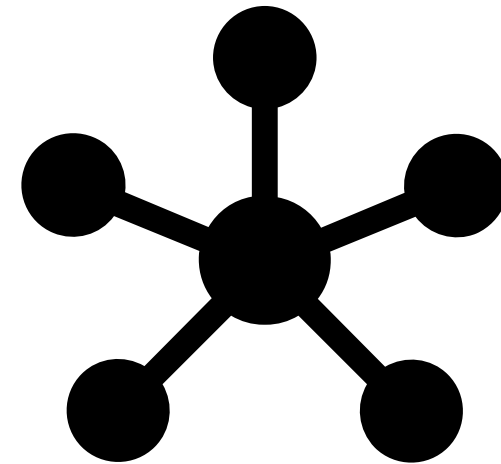
