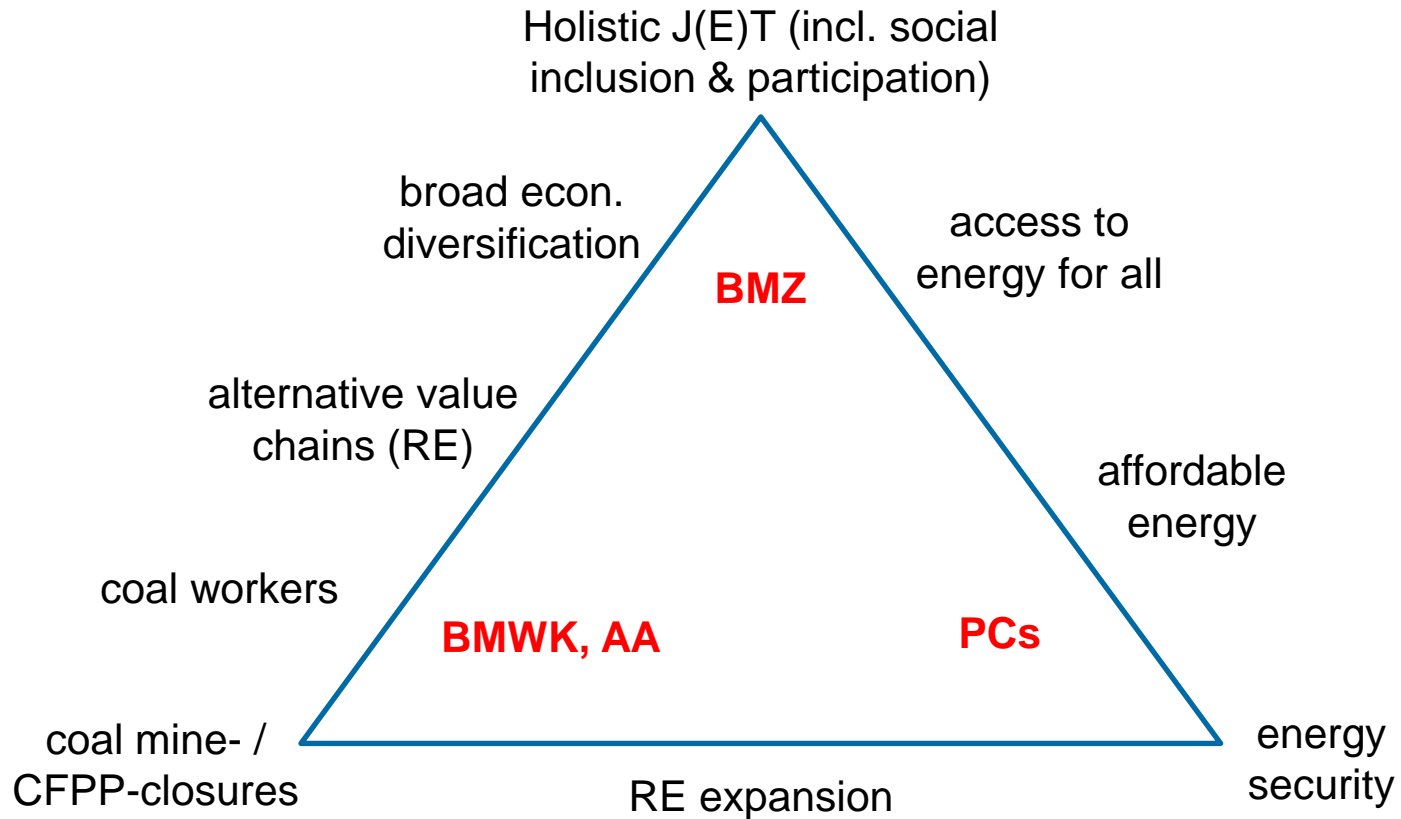
1) GIZ has the potential to play a key role in JET implementation

- J(E)T discourse resonates well with GIZ mission & work
- GIZ's role/potential well respected by commissioners & partners
- GIZ perceives itself well positioned (in the countries analyzed)

2) GIZ could/should improve the integration of energy & social issues within projects in emerging economies

- Projects often focused on either energy transition OR social issues
- Positive exception: JUST SA project in South Africa
- More integrated projects in the pipeline

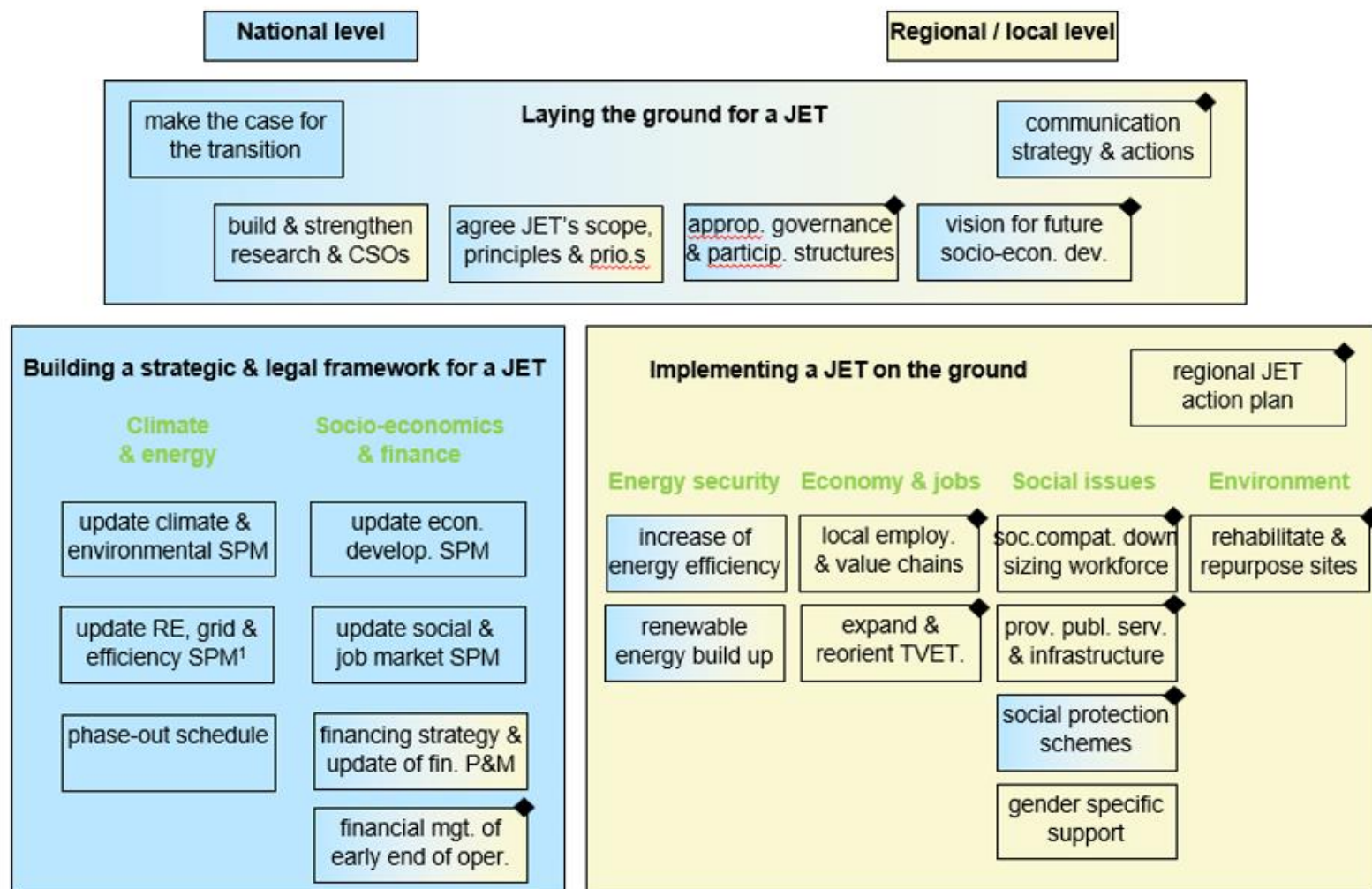
3) GIZ needs to consider different JET understandings & priorities among diff. financiers and partner countries
