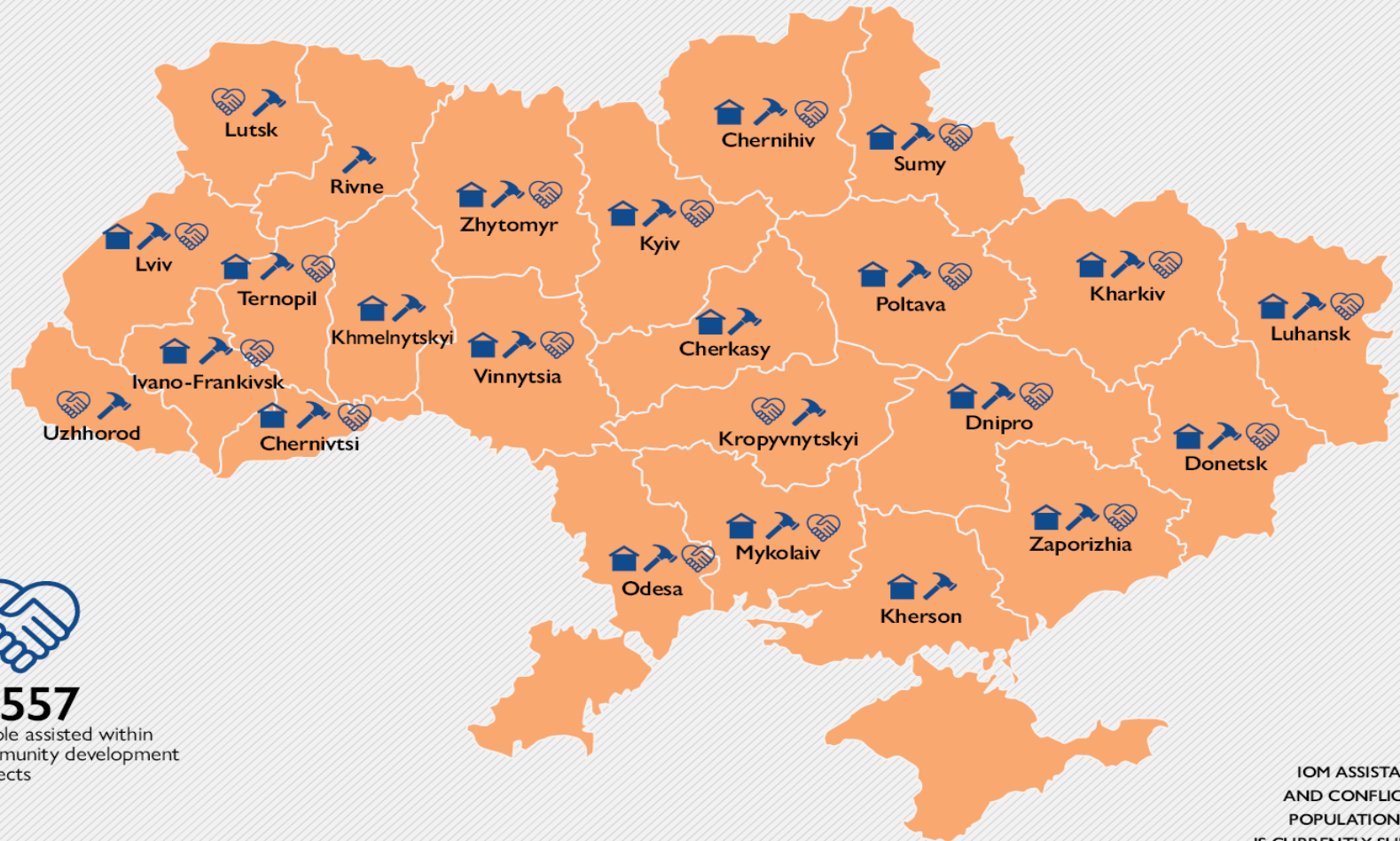

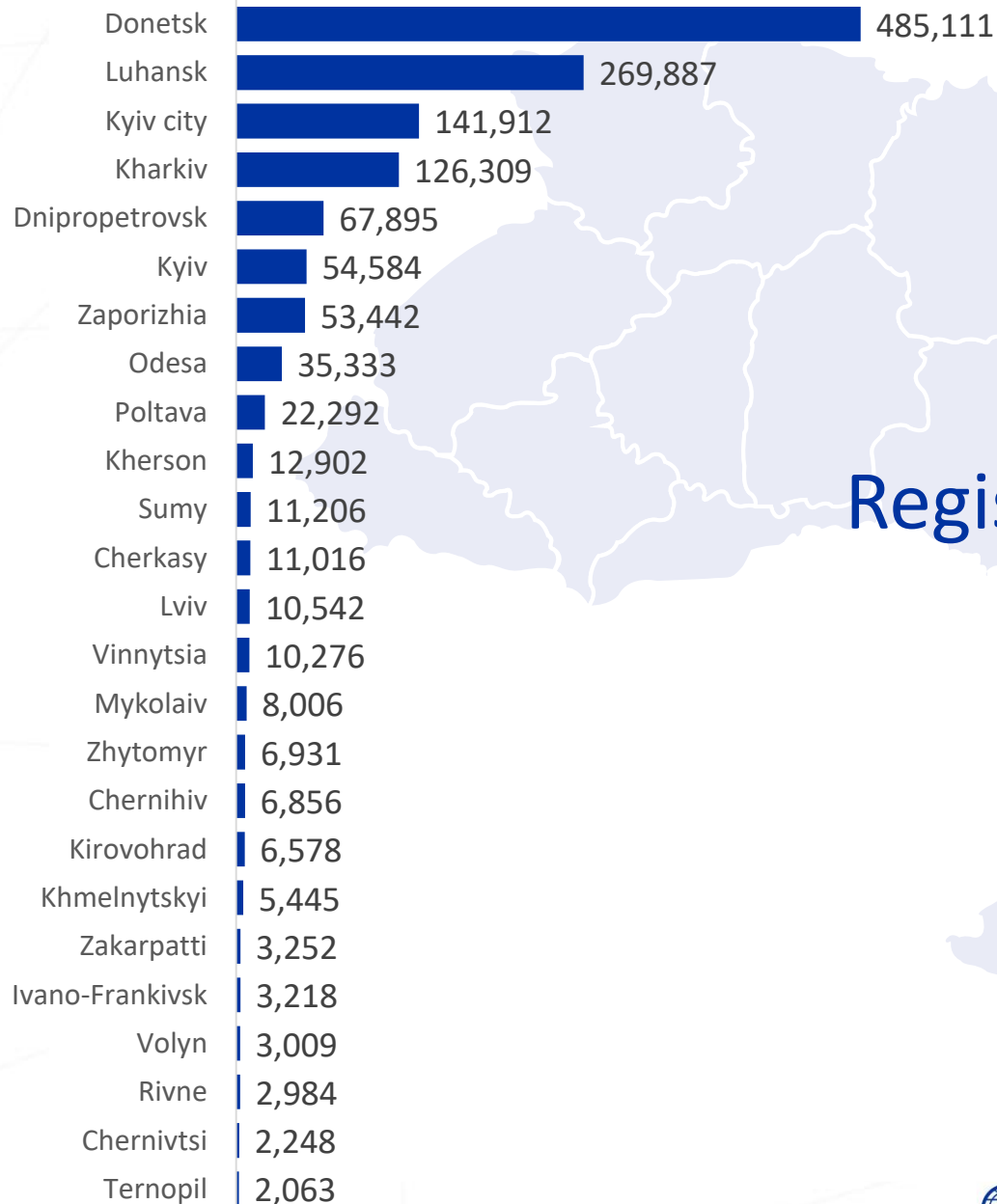

EMERGENCY HUMANITARIAN ASSISTANCE

Shelter/Non-Food Items (NFI)

Coal, winterization kits, cast-iron stoves and electric heaters were disseminated among **84,305 conflict-affected individuals**

Shelter

10,530 IDPs and local community members assisted within IOM's support to collective centers and individuals housing refurbishment

WASH related activities

Rehabilitation of WASH facilities in social institutions, distribution of diapers and hygiene kits supported **155,763 individuals**

CASH based interventions

Cash for rent, cash for work, multipurpose cash assistance and cash to cover transportation costs to visit medical facilities benefited **74,729 vulnerable individuals**

Other

35,101 IDPs and conflict affected population assisted with legal council, psychosocial support (PSS), special nourishment etc.
