In your role, you are responsible for the technical, substantive and organizational implementation of a project's measures and activities. You are also responsible for providing specialist support to colleagues in bands 2 and 3 and ensure the quality of the commission's outcomes.

In addition, you contribute to the conceptual design of the project, in particular its modification or realignment and are partly responsible for general project management tasks.

You make technical and substantive contributions to overarching issues in cooperation with commissioning parties/clients, partners and other actors and thereby support the

achievement of the agreed objectives of the respective project and provide impetus for further strategy development.

In coordination with the country director and your line manager, you also use your contacts for the acquisition of contracts on behalf of the company.

In consultation with your team colleagues and line manager, you also coordinate all issues within your area of work and ensure that they are dealt with promptly and competently.
