### About the project

Standards are the language of global trade and the basis for technological innovation. In a world of global value chains, a well-functioning and internationally harmonized quality infrastructure is essential for efficient trade and sustainable economic growth. International cooperation on norms and standards, accreditation and conformity assessment procedures, as well as market surveillance and product safety are crucial for facilitating trade, ensuring consumer protection and strengthening innovation capacities.

#### **A. Core Tasks**

In your role, you are responsible for the technical, substantive and organizational implementation of a project's measures and activities. In consultation with your line manager, you also take on tasks related to planning, steering and monitoring the project, including project administration tasks in some cases. You are also responsible for providing specialist support to colleagues in bands 2 and 3 and ensure the quality of the commission's outcomes.

In addition, you contribute to the conceptual design of the project, in particular its modification or realignment and are partly responsible for general project management tasks.

You make technical and substantive contributions to overarching issues in cooperation with commissioning parties/clients, partners and other actors and thereby support the achievement of the agreed objectives of the respective project and provide impetus for further strategy development.

In coordination with the country director and your line manager, you also use your contacts for the acquisition of contracts on behalf of the company.

In consultation with your team colleagues and line manager, you also coordinate all issues within your area of work and ensure that they are dealt with promptly and competently. You re- solve problems that arise in your area of responsibility on the basis of existing rules and draw attention to more complex challenges in your team.

You are involved in ongoing process development within your remit, are responsible for knowledge management and prepare and share documentation. If required, you also support other experts in familiarizing themselves with and performing their tasks.

You perform the tasks assigned to you by your line manager, where required.

## **B. Main Activities**

- Develop and maintain relationships with private sector stakeholders and related organizations (companies, business associations, chambers of commerce e.g., EKONID), serving as a key interface between the Global Project Quality Infrastructure (GPQI) and industry as well as towards the political partner, the Ministry of Industry.
- Drive private sector engagement in GPQI priority areas, including technical dialogues to strengthen industry engagement.
- Monitor and analyse current and emerging developments related to quality infrastructure, regulatory frameworks, and industry needs in Indonesia and internationally (Germany, the EU, etc.), and assess their implications for private sector cooperation under GPQI.
- Conceptualise, design, prepare, organise, facilitate, and document stakeholder dialogues, workshops, trainings, and conferences involving the private sector.
- Collaborate with cross-functional teams and partners to develop tools, resources, and analytical outputs that strengthen private sector engagement and policy–industry dialogue within GPQI.
- Represent GPQI in exchanges with high-level private sector stakeholders, business forums, industry roundtables, and trade-related events with a strong private sector presence.
- Identify and assess private sector needs, incentives, and barriers related to quality infrastructure and regulatory compliance, and translate them into actionable GPQI interventions.
- Assist the Cluster Coordinator and Country Director on overarching issues related to the implementation of the GIZ corporate strategy (eq. GIZ Vision 2028).

### C. Qualifications

- University degree in an area relevant to the project, preferably in economics, business administration, public policy/administration, social science, or a related field.
- Minimum of 5 (five) years professional experience in private sector engagement, business development, industry cooperation, or public-private partnership.
- Established professional network with private sector stakeholders, including business associations and chambers of commerce (e.g. EKONID, EuroCham), and industry representatives.
- Proven experience in working with stakeholders from the industrial sector (companies, business associations, and industry stakeholders) in Indonesia / Germany.
- Strong stakeholder management and relationship-building skills.
- Preferable knowledge of at least two of the mentioned QI Elements: standardization, accreditation, conformity assessment, and market surveillance.
- Ability to identify emerging trends and business implications related to regulation or standards.
- Full working fluency in English (C1 level) and Bahasa Indonesia, German proficiency is an asset.
- Very structured and well-organised working style and good skills in the use of digital tools
- Proactive, results-oriented, and able to work independently in a dynamic environment
