- Support political partners and the private sector to mobilise finance for scaling up climate action
- Develop knowledge products and training formats to contribute to capacity development of political partners and other stakeholders
- Manage services tendered out to external consultants and control their quality
- Prepare, facilitate and document events in different contexts (trainings, conferences, consultations, study tours)
- Ensure alignment and leverage synergy through knowledge exchange with other GIZ projects in related areas.
- Support strategic, financial and operational planning, monitoring and reporting
- Perform other tasks at the request of management related to the successful implementation of the project

- Master’s degree in a course related to transport, energy, environment or economics
- At least 5 years of relevant professional experience in the transport, automotive, green technology sectors or related sectors, with strong advisory and project implementation component
- Proven experience working with ministries and government agencies in Ghana or other African countries
