About GIZ India:

About SuATI

The technical cooperation project “Support to agroecological transformation processes in India (SuATI)”, funded by the Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ) and implemented by "Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH", supports agroecological transformation processes in close coordination with the national partners, Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare (MoA&FW), the National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) and the Ministry of Rural Development (MoRD). SuATI is focused on the states of Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh and Assam. The project strategy aims to combine the numerous and heterogeneous approaches to increasing the sustainability of Indian agricultural and food systems under the umbrella of the agroecological paradigm and thus help the Indian transformation agenda for sustainability including the Natural Farming Guidelines to gain greater momentum and effectiveness. Promotion of group farming, farmer producer organisations, farmer producer companies, and women self-help groups by transforming them towards agroecological-driven organic and natural farming practices is being undertaken at the level of national and state-focused programmes which are supported by SuATI accordingly.

SuATI interventions focus on the areas:

- To support farmer organisations to implement additional agroecological approaches.
- To support market development for agroecological products including addressing consumer awareness and consumer behaviour.
- To support the application of public financed measures for landscape-based implementation of agroecological approaches.
- To integrate measures for the implementation of agroecological approaches in national programmes and support their implementation.
- To promote the exchange and coherent application of knowledge on agroecological practices in cooperation with existing knowledge networks and research, training, and extension institutions.
- To support the Indo-German Lighthouse Agroecological and Sustainable Management of Natural Resources as anchor project, including bilateral and multistakeholder dialogue processes, knowledge management and communication under the initiative.

A. Description of the Position:

Under the supervision of the Project Communications Specialist, the intern will support the development of high-quality knowledge products and communication materials with extensive design work. The intern will also contribute to knowledge management, documentation, and coordination of communication-related activities.

B. Core scope of work

The specific tasks of the Intern will include:

1. Support in designing of communication materials and knowledge products under different outputs of the project such as but not limited to brochures, reports, presentations, social media content
2. Assist in knowledge management and documentation, including preparation of meetings, meeting notes, events and its reports, consolidation of reports etc.
3. Provide support in the planning and coordination of meetings, workshops, and events, especially logistical arrangements. Contribute to content development for communication outputs, including drafting, editing, and formatting materials.
4. Any other relevant tasks assigned from time to time.

C. Required qualifications, competences and experience

Qualifications:

- Post-graduate or master's degree (completed not more than 6 months ago) in graphic designing and communications. Background in development studies, social sciences, or related areas is preferred.
- Proficiency in design software such as Adobe Creative Suite including InDesign, Illustrator, Photoshop is a must.
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office Suite (Word, Excel, PowerPoint).
- Proficiency in the English language along with good writing skills.
- Strong organisational skills and attention to detail.
- Enthusiastic, proactive, self-motivated, and adaptable.

- Work samples of designed materials like brochure, flyers, posters or even reports.
- Previous internship experience or exposure in the areas of natural resource management, climate change, livelihoods, or agriculture.
