

Construction of WASH facility at Agbogbloshie, Accra

NATIONAL COMPETITIVE TENDER-CONSTRUCTION FIRMS REQUIRED

The objective of the EAT Programme is to support the improvement of institutional and technical preconditions for intraregional agricultural trade in selected countries in the ECOWAS region. Specifically, under outcome 2, the program aims to ensure that sustainable and gender-sensitive agricultural trade facilitation tools are available for coordination in ECOWAS bodies for implementation. As a result, trade will be simplified, faster in processing at borders and nodes, less costly, and more accessible and secure for women, which is a key requirement for intra-regional agricultural trade in the region.

The project carried out a specific study on gender in 2024, focusing on the challenges faced by women traders in the regional agri-food trade. These assessments and studies revealed a lack of infrastructure, including sheds in the markets, water, sanitary and hygiene (WASH) facilities at the borders and in the markets, to name a few. In Agbogbloshie market in Accra, existing WASH infrastructure in the markets was found in a very poor state of repair, with little or no water supply and no roofs.

The project, therefore, aims to upgrade a WASH facility for female traders in the Agbogbloshie market in Accra with the following objectives:

- Provide gender specific convenience facilities for female traders where they can comfortably relieve themselves under hygienic and safe conditions.
- Accord women traders the ability to stay longer at the border crossings or local markets, thereby allowing them the opportunity to generate more sales without interruption from long trips back home during business hours.
- Reduce open defecation and the spread of diseases, especially among traders handling food items.

The Project must be completed and handed over within seven (5) months. Contractors must demonstrate adequate staffing, equipment, and financial capacity to meet this timeline while maintaining strict quality standards.

Interested contractors with proven experience in this specific kind of construction are kindly requested to express interest in the above-mentioned project.

Please send a Letter of Interest (LoI) with following documents:

- Provide the copies of original documents defining the constitution or legal status, place of registration (Company Certificate), principal place of business and written power of attorney of the signatory.
- SSNIT, VAT and Tax Clearance Certificates.
- Provide references of construction projects in the last three years
- Provide the total value of construction work performed for each of the last three years.
- Provide audited turnover of the last three years
- Submit detail of Tools & Plans necessary to carry out the construction.
- Provide the necessary information about the qualified technical staff with their short CVs
- Provide proven evidence of adequacy of working capital preferable of a private bank of this assignment.

To All Bidders:
