B. Project Background

The India–Germany Platform for Investments in Renewable Energy Worldwide (The Investment Platform) was jointly launched by the Governments of India and Germany under the Green and Sustainable Development Partnership (GSDP) during RE-INVEST 2024. It serves as a strategic mechanism to strengthen framework conditions for investments in renewable energy component manufacturing, technology partnerships and resilient supply chains, supporting India's clean energy ambitions and the global goal of tripling renewable energy capacity.

Aligned with the vision of "Make in India, make for the World," the Investment Platform brings together governments, industry, financial institutions, research organisations and development partners to accelerate investment, strengthen manufacturing ecosystems, promote innovation and develop the skilled workforce needed to position India as a globally competitive hub for renewable energy manufacturing and supply chains.

The Investment Platform aims to accelerate investments in renewable energy, foster innovation and technology partnerships, and facilitate collaboration between government, industry, financial institutions, research organizations, and development partners. It contributes to India's ambition of achieving 500 GW of non-fossil fuel capacity by 2030 through a multi-stakeholder approach and four thematic Working Groups (solar photovoltaics, wind energy, energy storage and biogas).

The Secretariat of the Investment Platform, housed in GIZ India, serves as the coordination and facilitation hub for the Platform. The Secretariat convenes and supports Working Group meetings and consultations, facilitates dialogue between government institutions, industry associations, private sector stakeholders, financial institutions, research organisations, and development partners, and coordinates knowledge exchange across stakeholders. It also supports the design and organisation of workshops, conferences, and high-level engagement events, while working with investment agencies, development banks, and other financing partners to identify and advance investment opportunities and financing mechanisms that strengthen renewable energy manufacturing and supply chains.

C. Internship Job Description:

*The following job description is for an internship opportunity **to support the Secretariat of the Investment Platform**, housed with GIZ India. Key tasks have been identified below.*

Tasks to be undertaken:

- Assist in stakeholder mapping and maintaining communication with public and private sector partners, industry associations, academia, and development organizations.
- Support the planning, coordination, and documentation of Working Group meetings, workshops, consultations, and high-level events.

- Conduct background research and prepare briefing notes, presentations, meeting summaries, and knowledge products on renewable energy and investment-related topics.
- Support the preparation of minutes of meeting, communication materials, reports, presentations and other project deliverables.
- Assist in monitoring project activities and maintaining documentation and databases.
- Support in event planning and organising for conferences and relevant meetings.
- Provide administrative and organizational support to the project team as required.
- Undertake other tasks aligned with the objectives of the project.

Your Profile:

- Currently in the final year of, or recently graduated from, a Master's programme in Renewable Energy, Energy Policy, Public Policy, Economics, Finance, International Relations, Environmental Studies, Business Administration, or a related discipline.
- Strong interest in renewable energy, climate finance, sustainable development, climate policy, and / or international cooperation.
- Excellent analytical, research, and organizational skills.
- Strong written and verbal communication skills in English and Hindi; knowledge of German is an asset.
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office applications (Word, Excel, PowerPoint); familiarity with data analysis or visualization tools is an advantage.
- Ability to work independently as well as collaboratively in a multicultural and interdisciplinary team. Proactive and agile person, comfortable with driving activities with limited guidance, accustomed to navigating uncertainty with an ability to thrive in fast-paced, fluid environment. S/He is expected to be a lateral thinker and willing to work with strict deadlines.

Notes:

- The said engagement is for a duration of 6 months, and candidate will be positioned at the GIZ Delhi office. This position is only open for Indian students and citizens. In case of work-related travel, costs will be covered by the project within the framework of GIZ travel guidelines.
- The candidate is expected to arrange accommodation on their own.
- The candidate will be required to sign declarations on data protection and code of ethics as an annexure to their internship agreement.
- The candidate will be provided a stipend of INR 24,000/- per month plus INR 5,000/- transportation reimbursement. Taxes as applicable may be deducted from the stipend in accordance with law.
- Shortlisted candidates will be invited for an in-person/virtual interview.

Please be informed that you are only allowed to apply for this internship, if you are currently enrolled as a student or graduated no longer than six months ago from the start of your internship.
