The SC shall develop a comprehensive roadmap and plan focused on SDG 12.7 based on the draft Long-Term Action Plan (LTAP), outlining specific objectives, strategies, measurable outcomes, responsibilities, and timelines. Develop a monitoring framework for tracking the progress of SDG 12.7 activities, suggested to be based on UNEP's SDG 12.7 methodological guidelines. Develop baseline. Analyze the need for and assign technical working groups/task forces to support the SC's work. These groups are suggested to focus on SPP M&E, e-catalogue sectoral development, scaling SPP to the subnational level, certification processes, awareness and/or capacity development.
