















Zoriana: /zɔːˈriː.ənə/

An optimistic and creative teenage girl, who is passionate about environmental activism. She has a strong desire to spread joy and help others see the beauty in taking care of the planet.

Zoriana (Зоряна) - This name comes from the Ukrainian word "зоря", which means "a star". Therefore, Zoriana can be translated as "Starry" or "The one who belongs to the stars".



# **Tsvitan**: /ˈtsvɪ.tɑn/

Age: 13

A skeptical teenager, prone to believing in conspiracies and harboring low trust in environmental initiatives.

Tsvitan (Цвітан) - This name is derived from the Ukrainian word "цвіт", meaning "a bloom" or "a flower". Thus, Tsvitan symbolizes blooming or flowering, representing new life or spring.



## Chugaistic: /ˈtʃuː.gaɪ.stɪk/

A lively and sarcastically witty character, created from waste. He works at Ecoservice-2022 to help other wastes find their purpose through recycling while seeking their place in the world.

Chugaister is a fantastic figure of Ukrainian mythology, unknown to other peoples. He was imagined as a cheerful, joyful spirit of the forest. He was believed to have a cheerful disposition and to hunt spirits dangerous to humans and devour them.



### **Grandpa Antyp:** /ˈæn.tɪp/ Age: 60

An elderly individual withdrawn from community involvement. He prioritizes his personal needs over collective welfare and shows resistance to change or accept new ideas.

Antyp (Αιτυπ) - Antyp is a Ukrainian form of the Greek name Antipas (Αντίπας), which is a combination of "anti" meaning "against" and "pas" meaning "all". So, the name Antyp can be interpreted as "Against all" or "Resistant to all".














































































Some people considered it normal to simply dump their garbage here.
